## **Core Responsibilities**

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Serve as point leader for the following ministry areas:

### **1) Small Group Director**

- Serve leaders through training, resources and encouragement
- Oversee 60 – 70 Small Groups (women's, couples and mix singles) with the help of 8 SG Coaches
- Identify and recruit new leaders
- Visit Groups, huddles, one on ones as needed

### **2) Outreach Groups on Wednesday Morning**

- Continue to develop small groups on-site on Wednesday mornings for the purpose of Evangelism to the young mothers within our community.
- Research and provide curriculum focused towards young mothers and families.
- Continue to work with Children's Ministry to help develop more intentional programming for their children to entice attendance into groups.

### **3) Small Group Connections**

- Keep SG Web Directory up to date.
- Help SG Leaders develop appropriate wording to describe their groups and "encourage" them to have their information current on the web at all times.
- Continue training in using Church Teams as a shepherding tool through reports.
- Handle one on one request for people interested in Small Groups through phone, e-mail and response envelopes. Help direct them to a group that fits their lifestyle.
- Keep stats

### **4) First Time Visitors**

- Contact all First Time Visitors within days of their visit.
- Stay continually in tune with events and important information needed to transfer weekly to FTV's via e-mail, phone calls, or one on ones.
- Answer various questions from theological to types of ministries available. Pass along other requests to appropriate people to handle; i.e. Baptism, Volunteering, etc.
- Follow-up with weekly Feedback forms

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## 5) Identity Ministry – One on one counseling to POC contacts from women

- Collect contact requests via POC, e-mails, Sunday mornings, etc.
- Connect women in need with the best suited counselor
- Intercede, walk along side for a period of time until contact is connected in church either via serving or small groups.
